

2017 MGLQHA Queen Contest Rules

Queen will be crowned in May 2017. The Queen will represent MGLQHA at the All American Quarter Horse Congress in October 2017.

1. Candidate must complete an application and have it to the MGLQHA office by May 1, 2017, along with her photo and \$25 fee.
2. Candidate must be 18 years old on January 1, 2017 and not over 25 years old, single, never married, annulled, divorced, or be a single parent.
3. Previous Queen Contest winners are encouraged to enter. Please note that if such contestant has been Queen three times for this or any other organization, she will be ineligible.
4. Candidate must be a current member with AQHA & MGLQHA and also be a Michigan resident.
5. Candidate may ride any AQHA registered horse whose owner is a MGLQHA member.
6. Queen will automatically be on next year's MGLQHA Queen committee.
7. Candidate must compete in all categories:
 - A. Oral Interview 40 points (3 judges)
 - B. Written Test 40 points (questions from AQHA Rule Book)
 - C. Horsemanship 20 points (3 judges)(judged categories scores will be totaled and averaged)
8. Queen will appear at 5 shows, the Harbor Classic Show, and the Breeder's Futurity.
9. Queen will attend the awards banquet.
10. Queen will be responsible for thanking sponsors and for bringing and displaying Sponsor banner at any event she is attending as Queen.
11. If Queen is active showing your horse on MQ Circuit, the committee will, on a case by case basis, take into consideration, your showing commitments and Queen Duties and adjust appropriately.
